**BUSINESS**

D. Shannahan opened the meeting and welcomed those present.  
He introduced himself and the Council staff.

**Moved:** ***"That the minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting held on Monday 31 October 2005, be adopted as a true and correct record of that meeting."***

**MATTERS ARISING**

W. Moen pointed out that aerial spraying had been completed.  
He also noted that there had been a general drop in bed levels, with the channel tending to develop on the north side of the river.  
It was pointed out that this would be closely monitored to ensure the stopbank's integrity.  
It was requested the design analysis of the stopbank be undertaken to more accurately determine the service potential.  
S. Moran noted that there would be an element of benefit for the Rating District to pay a proportion of the cost of maintenance of cross sections.  
W. Moen noted that analysis needed to be carried out and that Grey District Council, Tranist, Eletronet, OnTrack could be approached to share the cost of this.  
S. Moran noted that approximate costs, based on previous areas analysis it could cost between \$5,000 - \$10,000.
